This act requires a residential contractor, adjuster, or insurer to notify a homeowner of the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 325E.66 in an initial estimate.

Section 325E.66 prohibits a residential contractor who is being paid from insurance proceeds from paying the owner's insurance deductible to induce the owner to hire him or her.
