Subject Metropolitan Council redistricting

Summary

The Minnesota legislature is required by Minnesota Statutes, section 473.123, subdivision 3a, to redraw the boundaries of Metropolitan Council districts every ten years after each decennial federal census. Such redistricting is to be effective in the year ending in the numeral “3.” Accordingly, the legislature was required to redraw the Metropolitan Council district boundaries in 2023.

This act identifies the redistricting map for Metropolitan Council districts (MC2023-2). The map is on file with the Geographical Information Systems Office of the Legislative Coordinating Commission and available to the public online.¹

Minnesota Statutes, section 473.123, subdivision 3e, which provided the previous Metropolitan Council district boundaries, is repealed.

This act applies in the counties of Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, and Washington and is effective the day following final enactment.
