Subject Hemp product laboratory testing

Summary

This act extends the expired laboratory testing requirements that allow for the testing of lower potency hemp edibles and hemp-derived consumer products that do not contain intoxicating cannabinoids at any accredited laboratory. This act delays the date that these hemp products must be tested at a Minnesota-licensed cannabis testing facility until after May 31, 2027.

Governor Tim Walz signed this act into law on March 27, 2026, and the act became effective the following day.
