Overview

This act requires the state and local governments to provide certain project payment information to a requesting contractor or subcontractor who is working on a public construction project.

Governor Tim Walz signed this act into law on May 12, 2026.

1	Payment information requests. Requires the state and local units of government (i.e., public contracting agencies)—upon the written request of any contractor or subcontractor participating in a public real property or highway construction project—to provide within seven calendar days specified information regarding any progress payment, retainage payment, final payment, or other project payment made by the public contracting agency. Required information includes the amount and date of the payment and a copy of the payment application submitted by the contractor. Provides that for highway construction contracts, a copy of the agency’s estimate or voucher satisfies this requirement. Requires public contracting agencies to make contact information available to subcontractors and, if the agency has a website, to provide this same contact information there. Allows the public contracting agency to request that contractors and subcontractors use an automated internet-based system for these payment information requests if the agency has such a system. Prohibits the state and local governments from charging any project contractor or subcontractor for providing the requested information.
