Overview

This act memorializes Master Sergeant Nicole Amor, a U.S. Army Reservist who was killed on March 1, 2026, during an unmanned aircraft system strike in Kuwait. It designates a stretch of Ramsey County State-Aid Highway 96 as “Master Sergeant Nicole Amor Memorial Highway,” and provides for memorial sign erection and maintenance by the appropriate road authority.

Sets requirements for memorial highway signs. Effective May 15, 2026.

Subd. 1. Sign requirements; costs. Directs the appropriate local road authority to post and maintain signs that reflect memorial designations established in this state statute, subject to sufficient funds identified from nonpublic sources. Directs the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) to act as a fiscal agent to collect donations for the signs and then provide the funds to the road authority.

Subd. 2. Sign requirements; removal. Sets out sign removal requirements.

Subd. 3. Master Sergeant Nicole Amor Memorial Highway. Designates Ramsey County State-Aid Highway 96, from U.S. Highway 61 to Interstate Highway 35E, as “Master Sergeant Nicole Amor Memorial Highway.”
