

scholarships each fiscal year distributed to two resident students, one boy and one girl, in each of the state's eight congressional districts.

(b) Makes scholarship amounts equal to the costs of the instruction and residential program, less the amount of general education revenue the school receives for a student.

Subd. 5. General education. Pays schools enrolling scholarship recipients the general education and operating capital revenue available to charter schools.

2 Appropriation. Appropriates \$720,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of children, families and learning for the purpose of section 1. Makes \$480,000 available in each fiscal year.
