Overview

This bill permits law enforcement agencies to sell forfeited firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories to purchasers whom the agency has determined are eligible to possess a firearm lawfully.

- 1 Disposition.** Permits law enforcement agencies to sell forfeited firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories to purchasers whom the agency has determined are eligible to possess a firearm lawfully. Under current law, law enforcement agencies are not permitted to sell these items at a forfeiture sale; rather, they are required either to destroy them or keep and use them for official use.
