### Overview

Requires the attorney general's consumer protection office and the department of human rights to have at least one employee in each of five specified areas of the state.

- 1 Consumer protection office.** Requires the attorney general, in cooperation with local units of government, to ensure that at least one employee of the consumer protection office is located in each of five specified areas of the state.
- 2 Human rights department.** Requires the commissioner of human rights, in cooperation with local units of government, to ensure that at least one employee of the department is located in each of five specified areas of the state.
