- 1 City aid base.** Permanently increases the city aid base or "grandfathered" portion of a city's LGA payment by \$102,000 beginning in 2000 if the city meets the following criteria:
  - its 1997 population is greater than 2,000;
  - its net tax capacity used in calculating its 1999 LGA is less than \$455 per capita;
  - its net levy used in calculating its 1999 LGA is more than \$195 per capita; and
  - the total 1999 LGA it is certified to receive is less than 38 percent of its total "unmet need" as determined by the LGA formula.The maximum *increase* in total LGA that the city may get in one year is also increased by \$102,000 for calendar year 2000. Only the city of Pine Island meets all four criteria.
