Overview

House File 105 is a resolution memorializing the United States Congress to repeal the Freedom to Farm Act of 1996; maximize hog slaughter capacity; purchase more pork and pork products; grant credit forbearance for hog and grain producers; expand the Emergency Disaster Loan Guarantee Program; increase marketing loan rates for grains; and investigate the proposed merger between Cargill, Inc. and Continental Grain Co.
