Overview

This bill appropriates \$120,000 from the general fund for bomb disposal expense reimbursements.

- 1 Appropriations.** Appropriates \$60,000 each year of the 2000-2001 fiscal biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety for the bomb disposal expense reimbursement program. Under this program, the commissioner may reimburse bomb disposal units for reasonable expenses incurred to dispose of or neutralize bombs or other similar hazardous explosives for their employer-municipality or for another municipality outside the jurisdiction of the employer-municipality but within the state. Reimbursement under the program is limited to the extent of appropriated funds.
