Overview

The "Passing On the Farm" center at Southwest Technical College in Granite Falls was created by legislation in 1995. House File 155 provides an appropriation, which must be matched by 1 nonstate dollar for each 4 state dollars, to fund the center through June 30, 2001.

1 Appropriation; Passing on the farm center. Appropriates \$75,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of agriculture for the passing on the farm center at Granite Falls to operate the center through the 2000-2001 biennium. The appropriation must be matched with one dollar of nonstate money (including in-kind matches) for each four dollars of state money.
