- **1 Petit jury.** Defines a petit jury to mean six persons impaneled and sworn by the court to try a question of fact in a civil or criminal case. Provides that in a felony criminal action a petit jury has 12 persons, unless the rules of criminal procedure provide a different size.
- 2 **Superseded rule.** Supersedes a jury management rule promulgated by the supreme court to the extent it conflicts with section 1.
- **3 Effective date.** Immediate for proceedings on and after that date.
