- **1 Building code violations.** Amends the government data practices act to provide that all code violations on a particular piece of real property and the improvements on it kept by a government agency responsible for enforcing health, housing, fire prevention or housing maintenance codes are public data.
- 2 **Code violations' disclosure.** Amends current landlord tenant statute to contain the same language added to the government data practices act in section 1. Under current law, which predates the data practices act, code violation information is available only to specified parties who have an interest in the property or who may request inspection of it.
