## Overview

This bill makes it a felony to provide alcohol to an underage person who becomes intoxicated and causes death or great bodily harm.

- 1. Unlawful acts. Makes it a felony to provide alcohol to an underage person who becomes intoxicated and causes or suffers death or great bodily harm because of the intoxication. Under current law, this conduct is a gross misdemeanor and only a person who sells alcohol to an underage person commits a felony.
- 2. Effective date. August 1, 1999 for crimes committed on or after that date.
