Subject:	Allowing school-age residents to participate in a district's extracurricular activities
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Overview

This bill proposes to make all school-age residents equally eligible to participate in a school district's extracurricular activities, regardless of whether the child is enrolled in a public, nonpublic or home school. Currently, programmatic, financial or other constraints can result in a school district allowing only students enrolled in a public school within the district to participate in the extracurricular activities offered by the district.

- **1 Board control of extracurricular activities.** Directs school boards to ensure that all resident school-age children, whether they attend a public, nonpublic or home school located within the district or in another district, are equally eligible to participate in the extracurricular activities offered within the district.
- 2 Effective date. Makes section 1 effective immediately.
