Overview

School districts receive health and safety revenue on an approved project basis to make capital repairs to their school facilities. A health and safety project qualifies for revenue if the project is authorized by statute. The health and safety statute covers certain removal costs associated with indoor air quality projects, but it does not cover the cost of new construction.

- Authorizes health and safety revenue for independent school district, No. 2125, Triton, for unreimbursed costs associated with indoor air quality problems at the Triton school. Requires the district to pursue reasonable options to recover its expenses from its insurance carrier and any parties responsible for the air quality problem.
- **Effective date.** Makes section 1 effective the day following final enactment.
