Overview

Appropriates funding for Cannon river watershed protection, for a portion of the Mill Towns trail, and for a joint powers board to prepare a Cannon river land use management and recreation plan.

- 1 Appropriation.** \$400,000 is for funding of the Cannon river watershed partnership for watershed protection efforts.
- 2 Appropriation.** \$350,000 is for a grant to the Cannon River Link Trail Board to acquire, plan, and administer construction of the Mill Towns trail, which connects the Cannon Valley trail to the Sakatah Singing Hills trail.
- 3 Appropriation.** Provides \$250,000 to a joint powers board in Steele, Rice, LeSueur, Waseca, Goodhue, and Dakota counties, and cities within the counties, for preparing a land use management and recreation plan for the Cannon river watershed.
