Compensation of jurors. Adds a new subdivision. Provides that if a juror in a civil case provides evidence of substantial hardship because of the length of a trial, the court must apportion as costs among all parties up to \$50 per day for the juror, in addition to whatever reimbursement or payment for services the juror receives by law or court rule.
