Prohibits the department of transportation from restricting any lanes on I-394 or I-694 exclusively for high occupancy vehicles (HOVs). Requires the department to re-designate the HOV lanes on those highways as reversible lanes during peak traffic periods.

Requires the department to change highway signs for safety purposes as a result of these changes.
