- 1 Medicines and medical devices.** Extends the sales tax exemption for medicine to vitamins, minerals, and other dietary supplements for human consumption. States that the supplement can be in powdered, tablet, capsule, or liquid form and includes enzymes, herbs, probiotics, and homeopathics. Also, the subdivision is reordered to improve its readability.
 - 2 Effective date.** Effective for sales made after June 30, 1999.
