Requires the department of transportation to limit all ramp meters on freeways during October, 1999, to flashing yellow lights only. Allows temporary closures and other traffic restrictions required by public safety.

Directs the department to report to the legislature by February 1, 2000, on the results of the ramp meter action. Makes a blank appropriation from the trunk highway fund for the report.
