Overview

This bill would allow certain temporary workers hired through labor organization hiring halls by the city of Minneapolis, special school district no.1 (Minneapolis), and the municipal building commission to participate in the employers' deferred compensation plan. Employees covered by the bill include skilled building and construction trades workers, stagehands and production technicians, electrical workers, and apprentices in each of these categories

- Specific agreement negotiating subjects. Requires that the agreements reached between labor organizations and the city of Minneapolis, special school district no. 1 (Minneapolis), and the municipal building commission for hiring skilled workers through labor organization hiring hall services must provide for the participation of the workers hired in the employers' deferred compensation plan.
- **Effective date.** Provides for section 1 to be effective the day following final enactment.
