Review of Certain Orders Involving Children. Requires that an order relating to custody, visitation, and support contain a six month review date. At the six month review, requires the court to make sure support and visitation provisions are being followed.

Provides for waiver of the six month hearing if both parties file an affidavit indicating the order is being followed.

Provides that statutory remedies for support and visitation may be imposed by the court for noncompliance.
