### Overview

In 1997, the legislature established a prospective policy of allowing a public post secondary institution to charge to a public high school the tuition costs of providing remedial instruction in reading, writing or math to a recent high school graduate. This warranty would apply to students graduating from a public high school on or after May 1, 1999. The bill proposes to repeal the warranty.

- 1 Repealer.** Repeals a prospective policy of allowing a public post secondary institution to charge as of May 1, 1999 to a public high school the tuition costs of providing remedial instruction in reading, writing or math to a recent high school graduate.
- 2 Effective date.** Makes section 1 immediately effective and, if the effective date is after May 1, 1999, makes the section retroactively effective to that date.
