Overview

This bill appropriates an unspecified sum from the general fund for intensive case management services for prostituted individuals.

Appropriation; crime victim ombudsman. Appropriates an unspecified sum from the general fund to the crime victim ombudsman for the 2000-2001 fiscal biennium. This money is for grants to organizations to provide intensive case management services for prostituted individuals; including crisis intervention, transportation, relocation, child care, telephone assistance, counseling, street outreach and information and referral. Organizations providing case management services to women of color, poor women, and women living in rural areas will receive preference.
