Overview

This bill appropriates an unspecified amount of money from the general fund to the commissioner of children, families and learning for grants to organizations that focus on the intervention and prevention of teenage prostitution.

The grants are made through the community crime prevention grant program which funds proposals from local government or nonprofit organizations. One of the qualifying projects for these grants is the amelioration and prevention of the effects of teenage prostitution.

Appropriation; department of children, families and learning. Makes a blank general fund appropriation to the commissioner of children, families and learning for grants under the community crime prevention grants program. The grants must be awarded to organizations that focus on intervention and prevention of teenage prostitution.
