This bill appropriates money to the Center for Crime Victim Services for a grant to Cornerstone Advocacy Services to provide emergency shelter and support services to battered women and their children.

Appropriation; Center for Crime Victim Services. Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2001, to the Center for Crime Victim Services for a grant to Cornerstone Advocacy Services. The appropriation is made under Minnesota Statutes, section 611A.32, the statute authorizing grants to programs that provide emergency shelter services and support services to battered women and their children.
