Overview

This bill appropriates unspecified amounts to the commissioners of economic security and corrections for expansion of funding for youth intervention program grants under Minnesota statutes chapter 268.30. Grants made with the additional funding may be either to expand existing programs or to establish new programs. These appropriations are not added to either agency's budget base.

Three percent of the appropriation must be spent on administration, training and technical support, and 1% of the appropriation is for a grant to the Minnesota Youth Intervention Programs Association for training and technical assistance to grantees.
