Allows dice to be kept and used on the premises of establishments licensed to sell alcoholic beverages if (1) they are used only for the games of "yatzee," "shake-a-day," "backgammon," "500 rummy," "who buys," "last chance," "liar's poker," "6-5-4," "horse," or "monopoly," and (2) the licensed establishment does not organize or participate financially in the games.

Under general law it is illegal for an establishment licensed to sell alcoholic beverages to keep or allow dice on the licensed premises.
