### Overview

Minnesota law generally prohibits corporations from owning farm land or operating a farm enterprise in the state. Several exceptions to the general prohibition currently exist. By amending the existing definition of "aquatic farm" House File 688 effectively adds an exception for greenhouses used for hydroponic farming.
