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## Overview

This bill requires the seller of a new home to inform the buyer that automatic fire protection sprinklers may be installed in the home.

- 1 Construction of residential dwellings; fire protection notification.
  - **Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines the terms "dwelling," "vendee," and "vendor." A dwelling is a new building constructed as a one-family residence, a vendee is the purchaser of a dwelling, and a vendor is the seller of a dwelling.
  - **Subd. 2. Fire protection system notification.** Provides that a seller of a newly constructed home must provide the buyer with the notification required by subdivision 3 at the time the purchase agreement, earnest money contract, or other contract for the purchase of the home is executed.
  - **Subd. 3. Notification contents.** Requires that the buyer must acknowledge in the contract or on a separate form that the buyer has been given a brochure on automatic fire protection systems or has been informed that automatic sprinklers may be available for the home.
