Overview

This bill is a memorial to Congress related to state tobacco settlement recoveries.

This bill presents findings related to the state's tobacco settlement, and memorializes the Congress and the Administration to support legislation that would prohibit the federal government from claiming or recouping any state tobacco settlement recoveries. The bill also requests that members of Minnesota's congressional delegation become cosponsors of legislation addressing this issue, and requests the Secretary of State to transmit copies of the memorial to the President, the U.S. Congress, and to Minnesota's congressional delegation.
