Repeals the following provisions of Minnesota Statutes:

169.01, subdivision 18, defining "trackless trolley" as a vehicle that draws power from overhead wires but does not run on rails.

169.38, requiring drivers to honk their horns within 200 feet of a curve when the driving is in "defiles or canyons or on mountain highways."

169.901, prohibiting hiring a person "addicted to the excessive use of intoxicating liquors" to drive a motor coach.
