### Overview

In 1991, the legislature authorized school districts to levy for disabled access projects. The levy authority for each school district was set at \$300,000 per district. The levy is unequalized (there is no state aid attached to the levy). Many school districts used all of their levy authority in the first few years. The levy was ultimately extended for an eight-year time period. However, not all districts have used their full levy authority. House File 105 allows the Pine City school district to use its remaining disabled access levy authority over the next five years.

### Section

- 1 **Disabled access levy; Pine City.** Extends by five more years the time available to independent school district No. 578, Pine City, to levy for disabled access projects.
