### Overview

Chapter 299M of the Minnesota Statutes governs licensing in the fire protection industry. Under that chapter, certain fees are collected for licensing, certification, and registration of fire protection contractors and employees. Under current law, those fees are deposited in the general fund. This bill provides that fees collected under chapter 299M be placed in a special revenue fund for the state fire marshal to administer the licensing duties.
