Overview

This bill requires that only one barber shop registration fee be charged for multiple barbers operated by a single barber who is the sole barber in each shop.

Section

- 1 **Annual renewal required.** Under current law, both an initial registration fee and an annual renewal fee are charged by the board of barber examiners for each barber shop. The bill would provide that if a single barber has multiple shops where that barber is the only barber working, only one renewal fee would be charged to renew the registration of all the shops. Each shop would pay a separate initial fee, but there would be a single renewal fee.
- 2 **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
