Overview

This bill provides funding for restorative justice programs and requires that they not provide services in domestic abuse cases.

Section

- 1 **Restorative justice programs.** Provides that restorative justice programs must not provide services in domestic abuse cases.
- Appropriation. Appropriates money for grants to restorative justice programs. Requires grant recipients to be chosen by an interagency committee with representatives from the department of public safety, the department of children, families, and learning, the department of corrections, the supreme court, the juvenile justice advisory committee, and the office of dispute resolution. Provides for community-based practitioner input. Provides for balanced geographic allocation and provides preferences.
