Overview

This bill repeals certain rules adopted by the board of chiropractic examiners and by the health department.

Section

1 **Rule repeal.** Paragraph (a) repeals rules adopted by the board of chiropractic examiners that establish an inactive retired license status, allow for annual renewal of that license, and address reinstatement to active status from inactive retired license status. (The board has begun the process of repealing these rules through rulemaking.)

Paragraph (b) repeals rules adopted by the health department that:

establish maximum permissible formaldehyde levels in housing units;units;

prohibit the use of roller towels in public places unless the towel dispensers meetmeet certain criteria to prevent the spread of communicable diseases; and

establish criteria for homes to be certified as lead-safe (the statute authorizing this this rule was repealed in 1999).
