### Overview

A school district is eligible for health and safety revenue to eliminate health or safety hazards. Eligible uses of health and safety revenue include:

removing or encapsulating asbestos; asbestos;

disposing of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs); (PCBs);

removing or disposing of fuel oils; oils;

eliminating fire hazards; hazards;

removing life safety hazards; and

certain health, safety and environmental management costs.

Health and safety revenue is a partially equalized aid and levy. According to preliminary budget information health and safety revenue will total approximately \$90 million statewide in fiscal year 2002.

H.F. 297 authorizes the Lac qui Parle Valley school district to include certain nurse and medical provider costs in its health and safety plan.

### Section

- 1 **Health and safety; Lac qui Parle Valley.** Authorizes independent school district No. 2853, Lac qui Parle Valley, to include in its approved health and safety program costs the costs associated with the employment of a school nurse during the school day and for certain on-duty

medical providers for after-school practices and activities.
