## Overview

This section provides additional notice and voting requirements for neighborhood organizations organized as nonprofit corporations.

## **Section**

- 1 **Neighborhood organizations.** Provides notice requirements for neighborhood organizations. Requires that notice be given thirty days before a meeting is held, and must be posted in all public buildings in the neighborhood area, as well as published in the neighborhood's community newspaper or newsletter.
- 2 **Right to vote.** Generally, nonprofit corporations (which include neighborhood organizations) are required to allow members to vote. This section would require that neighborhood organizations allow all people who reside in the neighborhood and appear at a meeting to vote on the business undertaken in that meeting.
