Overview

Provides that it is an unfair labor practice for a public employer to unilaterally modify any benefit received by a retired public employee on the date of retirement under a collective bargaining agreement. Current law provides that a person may bring a district court action for injunctive relief or for damages caused by an unfair labor practice.
