Overview

This bill transfers \$175,000 in each year of the biennium from the lottery prize fund to the general fund to be used for a grant to a compulsive gambling council.

Section

- 1 **Transfer.** Requires the director of the state lottery to transfer \$175,000 each year of the biennium from the lottery prize fund to the general fund.
- 2 **Appropriation; adolescent compulsive gambling grant.** For each year of the biennium, appropriates \$175,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to a compulsive gambling council located in St. Louis county. Requires the gambling council to provide a statewide compulsive gambling prevention and education project for adolescents. Allows any unencumbered balance in the first year to be available for the second year.
