Overview

This bill appropriates money to the supreme court administrator and commissioner of public safety to reimburse Carlton county for extraordinary expenses relating to homicide trials in 2000.

Section

- 1 **Appropriation; supreme court.** Makes a one-time appropriation to the supreme court administrator to be used to reimburse Carlton county for extraordinary expenses related to homicide trials in 2000.
- 2 **Appropriation; public safety.** Makes a one-time appropriation to the commissioner of public safety to be used to reimburse Carlton county for extraordinary expenses related to homicide trials in 2000.
