Overview

This bill provides an exception to the hospital moratorium and nursing home moratorium, to allow replacement of a hospital and attached nursing facility in St. Peter.

Section

- 1 **Restricted construction or modification.** Amends § 144.551, subd. 1. Provides an exception to the hospital moratorium for a project to replace a hospital with 36 licensed beds and an attached nursing facility in St. Peter, provided that the new hospital and attached nursing facility are located within city limits and the project does not result in an increase in hospital or nursing facility beds.
- 2 **Exceptions for replacement beds.** Amends § 144A.071, subd. 4a. Provides an exception to the nursing home moratorium to license and certify a new hospital-attached nursing home of 85 beds, as part of a project to replace a hospital and attached nursing facility in St. Peter, provided that the new hospital and attached nursing facility are located within city limits and the project does not result in an increase in hospital or nursing facility beds.
