This bill would direct the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to give priority to no more than three proposals for pilot projects encouraging homeowners to make exterior improvements to deteriorating properties, when selecting among proposals for funding under the community rehabilitation fund program.

The community rehabilitation fund program is the MHFA's largest program targeted at rehabilitation and construction of owner-occupied housing, with grants or loans under the program going to cities, nonprofit organizations, and for-profit developers for housing for households at or below 115 percent of the greater of the state or area median income.
