### Overview

In the past decade average yields from soybeans have been negatively affected by several diseases and plant pests that have proven to be increasingly difficult to control. The disease and pest problems are exacerbated by attempts to grow soybeans in more northerly locations. House File 572 appropriates a blank amount of general fund money for soybean disease and genetics research.

### Section

- 1 Appropriation; soybean diseases and genetics.** A blank sum is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of agriculture for a grant to a qualified organization to research various soybean diseases. A blank amount may also be used for soybean genetic research.
