### Overview

Independent school district No. 306, Laporte, received a maximum effort capital loan of \$7.2 million from the 2000 Legislature to help the district construct a new school.

On a separate track, the 2000 Legislature also broadened the scope of the school district review and comment process and school facility commissioning process to require that, for facilities that are placed in service after July 1, 2002, the facility's heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system must meet or exceed the standards set in code and that the facility's design provides for the monitoring of outdoor airflow and total airflow of the ventilation system. The air flow equipment must also provide a filtration system with a current ASHRAE standard.
