Overview

This bill contains appropriations for community corrections act grants, grants to increase supervision and treatment of sex offenders, and grants for statewide productive day initiative programs.

Section

- Appropriations; community corrections act grants. Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund to the commissioner of corrections for Community Corrections Act subsidy grants under section 401.10. Requires this appropriation to be included in the budget base for the 2002-2003 biennium.
- Appropriations; grants to increase supervision and treatment of sex offenders.

 Appropriates an unspecified amount from the general fund to the commissioner of corrections for grants to increase supervision and treatment of sex offenders who are on probation, intensive community supervision, supervised release, or intensive supervised release. Requires the grants to be used to provide treatment and reduce the number of offenders supervised by officers with specialized caseloads to an average of 35 offenders. Requires the commissioner to distribute the grants according to the formula contained in section 401.10. Specifies that this appropriation is an ongoing one.
- Appropriations; grants to the statewide productive day initiative program. Appropriates an unspecified amount to the statewide productive day initiative program defined in section 241.275. Contains unspecified appropriation amounts for programs in various areas. Specifies that these appropriations are available until June 30, 2003.
