Subject: Listing Carisoprodol as a Controlled Substance

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Overview

This bill amends the effective date provision listing Carisoprodol as a schedule IV controlled substance. This bill provides that the drug shall be listed under schedule IV on the effective date of a final rule adding Carisoprodol to the federal schedules of controlled substances.

Section

- Effective date. Amends the effective date provision listing Carisoprodol as a schedule IV controlled substance to provide that the drug shall be listed under schedule IV on the effective date of a final rule adding Carisoprodol to the federal schedules of controlled substances under United States Code, title 21, section 811. Schedule IV substances are substances that have a low potential for abuse relative to substances in Schedule III, a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States, and have limited physical dependence or psychological dependence stemming from abuse relative to the substances in Schedule III.
- 2 **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective August 1, 2001.
